Works Comprised:

- Rebuilding of sections of partially-collapsed sea wall in traditional dry-stone walling techniques.
- Reconstruction of stone pontoon comprising horizontally and vertically-bedded dry stone walling.
- Construction of new stone-pitched revetment with exposed aggregate finish to the concrete pointing.
- Construction of new access ramp down to beach – also with exposed aggregate finish.
- Refurbishment of the Lime Kiln comprising reconstruction of crenalations and sections of partially-demolished walls. Repointing of Kiln with Lime Mortar.
